

I absolutely love the conversations that happen during pregnancy test appointments. These are real and vulnerable moments. Some of these clients already know they are pregnant and are just looking for a verification of pregnancy. However, some of these

clients are finding out for the first time that they are pregnant. Some are super excited. Some are shocked. Some are scared. And some are very undecided about their plans for the future of the child they are carrying.

In these moments, we, as advocates, must rely on the Holy Spirit to discern what the client needs. Are they worried about finances? Are they concerned about how their partner or family will respond? Are they wondering how this will affect their career? Are they nervous about how they will parent well? Do they need insurance? Do they have adequate housing? Do they require emotional support? We need to determine the roadblocks that may prevent this client from choosing life for her baby.

The Pregnancy Care Clinic has been blessed with amazing resources. Being able to offer these resources helps many parents who are unsure about the future. We love that we can give a client a bag full of clothes, so they don't have to decide between clothing for baby and adequate food on the table. Maybe you've heard about the recent recall on certain Similac formulas; we've been able to help families who cannot currently find formula or find themselves needing to switch formula brands and aren't sure what to try. We had so many diapers that we were able to double the number of diapers we were handing out to clients each month.

We also give our clients information regarding housing, insurance, WIC, medical facilities & doctors/midwives, visiting nurses, and so much more.

During each in-take appointment, we take time to listen to each client's story about their faith journey (if they are willing to share). It is amazing to hear our clients' stories. Most of the time, we share part of our testimony about the saving grace of Jesus with the client. I had one client recently that when I asked about her faith journey, she stated that she didn't have one but was

really interested to know more about what that means. I was able to share about Jesus and the salvation that we can receive freely through Him. It was a beautiful moment, and I pray that this client continues to seek the Lord.

As I celebrate my first anniversary this month with the Pregnancy Care Clinic, I can't help but think back about all the lives that have been changed this past year. This is an incredible ministry. I know God has big plans for the future of the PCC. It's an honor to have a front row seat to watch Him work. With your continued partnership, we will save lives: physically, emotionally, and spiritually.

"No Season is Ever Wasted"

It has been an interesting 2 years here at the PCC: staff transitions, increased clientele (YAY!), my own personal health issues...to name a few.

I've had moments of serious frustration, crying out to God...WHY?!

Then, as our Loving Father always does...He spoke, in the form of two quiet whispers.

I had the privilege of meeting the sister of a dear friend. We have similar diagnoses, and something amazing happens when you are able to communicate your hurt, pain, and frustration with someone else who has been there too. During our conversation she shared some wisdom that went straight to my heart: "Stop asking God, "Why" and start asking God, "What"?" Instead of "why am I going through this?" ask "what does God want me to learn?" or "what should I be doing next?"

It's a powerful mindset shift. One that I try to implement in my daily walk with God, and one that I have the opportunity, Holy Spirit led, to share with our clients.

It takes a while to wrap your brain around change, especially if it's unexpected. In this continuing season of health issues, a mug came across my phone screen (above) with the simple words "No season is ever wasted". Cue the tears. No matter how discouraged, frustrated, angry, annoyed we are... God doesn't waste anything, His ways are so VERY purposeful. Another point I keep in the back of my mind as I see clients and hear their own personal struggles with their "why"?

We have had several clients with unexpected pregnancies in the last few months, and it has been a privilege to walk with them from "why" to "what". The client who will be putting her baby up for adoption. The client who will still be able to go through nursing school AND carry her pregnancy. The client who was hoping for pregnancy and is now dealing with pregnancy loss. Please continue to keep our staff and volunteers in your prayers as we work together, by the leading of the Holy Spirit, to connect, listen, and help our clients move toward their "what".
